

CDBA/CDLC Listserve Guidelines

1. The list is unmoderated. If you are a member of the list and send an e-mail to the relevant address, your posting will (or should) appear promptly in the mailboxes of all members just as you wrote it. Most of the common-sense policies the group has evolved over the years are designed to maximize the benefits and reduce the costs of that feature.
2. Before you post a message to the group, consider whether the message might be better addressed to an individual member. Responses to very specific queries (e.g. covering an appearance), kudos, or other personal messages should be sent off-list.
3. The list is for the facilitation of defense work in criminal cases. All recipients are under an obligation to take reasonable measures to preserve the applicability of work product and similar protections.
4. Routine requests for address changes, account suspensions and similar items are implemented by Executive Director Ben Kington (bk@boyce-schaefer.com).
5. Common courtesy dictates that whining, ranting, and raving be kept to an absolute minimum and that direct personal attacks on one another be avoided altogether. Gossip, rumors, and other idle chatter is also frowned upon by the group. The purpose of this list is to share practical information and relevant practice tips designed to enhance our practice of criminal defense law in San Diego County and not to prattle on about ourselves or others.
6. You are encouraged to include your full name, affiliation and contact info (as opposed to just an internet handle like Freeseveryone@aol.com) in postings.
